**BGA REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS**

**YOUR CHILD MUST:**

- 1. ATTEND ALL DAYS OF BGA**  
 Friday February 17 6-7:30 PM; Saturday February 18 10 AM-Noon and 1:30 PM-3:30 PM; and  
 Sunday February 19 10 AM-Noon. Participatory Main Stage performance between noon and 1:00 on Sunday.
- 2. BE OF SCHOOL AGE (5-17 years) and have some basic skills in the instrument**
- 3. SUPPLY HIS OR HER OWN INSTRUMENT (guitar, mandolin, fiddle, dobro, banjo, or bass)**

**FEES:** While the Joe Val Bluegrass Academy for Kids is brought to you in part by the BBU Education Fund and the generosity of our sponsors, we need additional support in order to continue to bring your family this program. We are asking you to share the cost by contributing \$25 per child. Of course, any donations in excess of this amount are also welcome. Your donation is tax deductible and receipts are available.
